Requirements of the applicant

- Enthusiastic, personable and committed;

- Able to inspire and motivate junior golfers;
- Dedicated to supporting junior golf development;
- A working knowledge of elite junior golf / or a willingness to learn.

England Golf Safeguarding and Protecting Children Requirements

Roles and Responsibilities

- The focus of the role will be to assist the regional coach with the delivery of the regional coaching programme and to successfully manage and mentor the players to give them the best environment for their golf development;
- Manage a squad which will comprise of approximately eight players each chosen at an Assessment Weekend;
- Attend up to 20 days of coaching, plus attendance at the England Golf performance conference, coach and manager education days and any relevant team meetings and tournament attendance.

Volunteer Role Description

Post Title:	Regional Manager (Voluntary)
Team:	Performance
Responsible To:	Assistant Performance Manager (male golf)
Term of Appointment:	Initial two-year appointment

Purpose:

To assist the regional coach by managing the squad efficiently and effectively in order that the players are given the best environment to improve and enjoy the squad experience.

Working Relationships:

Internal:

- Assistant Performance Manager – regular meetings and communication
- Performance team– regular communication
- England Golf Coaches (National and Regional) – regular communication as required.
- Players and parents – managing and building excellent working relationships with players and their parents.
- Sport Science and Medicine Coaches – communication as required.

Main Duties & Key Responsibilities:

- Work with the regional coach and the performance manager to develop a plan and schedule for support and development of players in the squad.
- Liaise with, and assist, England Golf Performance personnel to develop and deliver the performance aspects of the England Golf Strategic Plan and to ensure matters relating to regional coaching are brought to their attention.
- Support and communicate effectively with the U18 regional squad coach in the delivery of the regional coaching programme, by predominantly managing and mentoring squad players, and facilitating the creation of a performance and development minded environment.
- Liaise with the counties in the region during the season to obtain information on potential players for inclusion in the squad, and to share best practice.
- Make recommendations to the selectors and the performance manager on players for potential inclusion in the England Golf national U18 squad coaching programme and to ensure that players that are not selected are brought to the attention of the selectors and performance manager if their playing standard warrants close attention.
- Attend agreed national age group events and relevant local events, to scout for players to be included in the regional squad, meet parents, and provide players with support and advice in line with the England Golf performance programme and strategy.
- Attend and represent the region at the England Golf performance conference, coach and manager education days, and any relevant team meetings.
