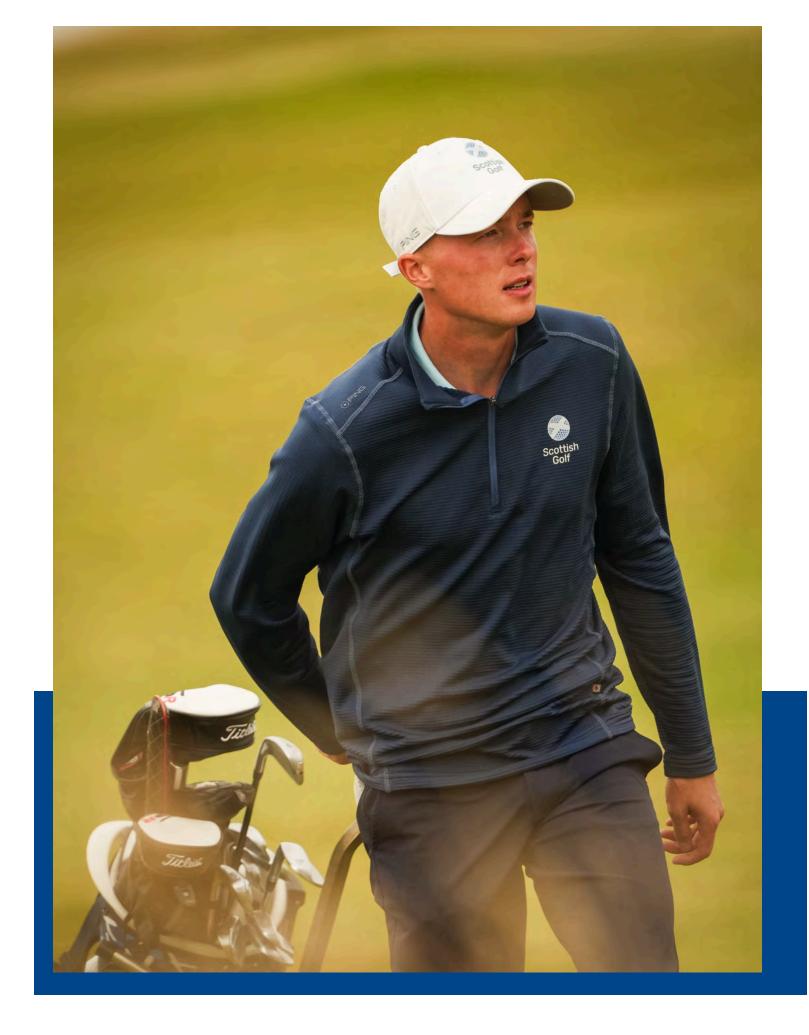
# OUR MISSION

This role requires the successful candidate to work closely with host venues and sponsors to deliver high quality events that are open and accessible for all.

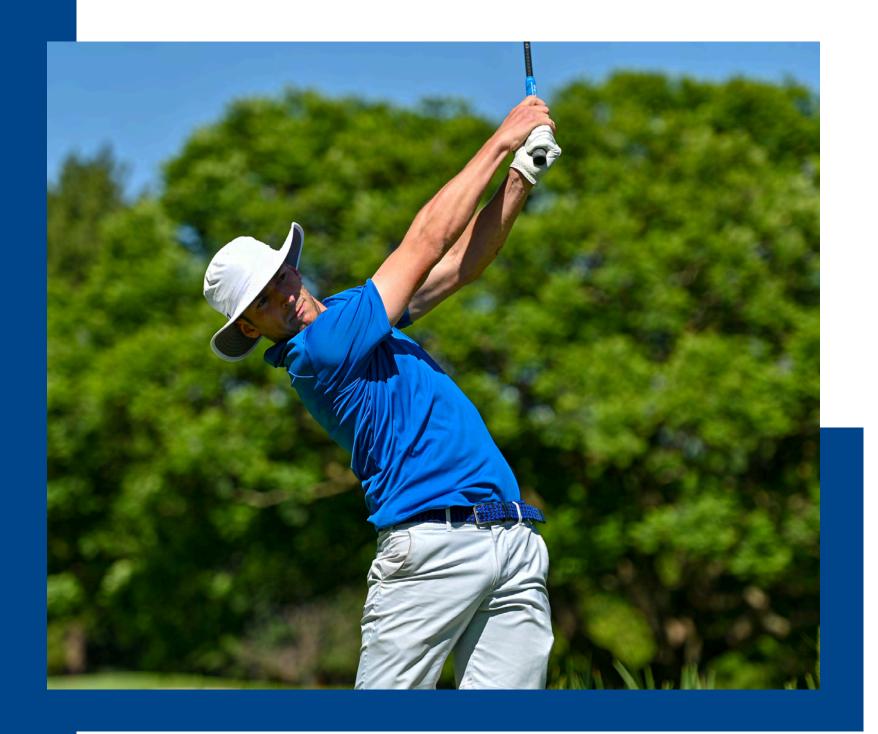

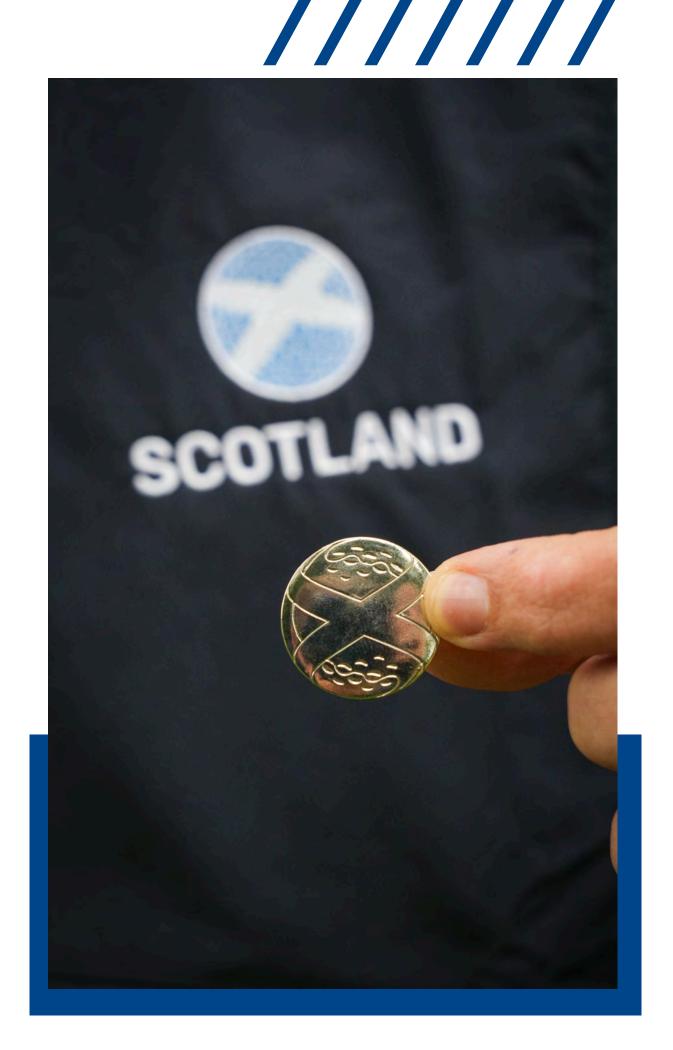
